

In an emergency event such as a fire, the occupier of a workplace must have ready a predefined procedure and competent personnel, to ensure rapid and safe evacuation of all persons from the premises. In addition to emergency evacuations, nominated personnel should be responsible for ensuring any appropriate fire prevention practices, detection and alarm systems, extinguishers, signage, escape routes, etc are all kept in a suitable condition and maintained in accordance with statutory / planned arrangements.

This course covers the role of those nominated fire marshals and explains the action which they should undertake both on a day-to-day basis and in an emergency situation. The content is suitable for personnel responsible for overseeing fire safety, designated fire marshals and anyone who needs to know what actions to take in the event of a fire.

The training provides a good overview of fire regulations, prevention measures and responses and it aims to provide delegates with the knowledge to be become a nominated fire marshal.

Included within the course are some key points, as follows...

- Legislation and requirements for the Employer and Employee
- The role of the fire marshal
- Dealing with the emergency services
- How a fire works (the 'fire triangle')
- Common causes of fire
- Fire safety precautions
- Action on discovering a fire
- Fire drills, evacuation, muster points and roll call
- Fire extinguishers (types and application)

All delegates receive handout information and, rather than a formal assessment, delegates will be assessed by the trainer throughout based upon participation and demonstration of understanding. Upon successful completion of the course certificates of training will be issued.
