

The Management of Health and Safety at Work Regulations 1999 state that, where five or more people are employed, documented risk assessments on all work activity shall be undertaken.

This training course is generally recommended for managers, supervisors and foremen etc., who are required to assess risk and oversee safe working practices. No previous experience is necessary however, a knowledge of the work activities they plan to assess is recommended.
